Checklist: Travelling with Pets in the Aircraft Cabin

Before the Journey

Check the pet entry requirements for all relevant countries and airlines involved in your trip.



Register your pet with the airline early - ideally at the time of booking.

Arrange any required veterinary checks and vaccinations, and ask your vet about possible calming medication.

Make sure all required documents (e.g. pet passport, vaccination certificates, airline forms) are complete and easily accessible.

Get a suitable travel carrier with an absorbent lining and proper ventilation.

Help your pet get used to the carrier well in advance, and place a familiar blanket or toy inside.

Pack a suitable leash and either a harness (recommended) or collar.

Checklist: Travelling with Pets in the Aircraft Cabin

Before Depature

- Give your pet access to food and water well before departure not too close to the flight to avoid nausea.
- Give your pet enough exercise beforehand to move around and relieve itself.
- Arrive at the check-in desk with your pet in its carrier around 2 hours before departure.
- Present all official and veterinary documents at check-in. Ensure your pet wears a harness or collar, and keep the leash easily accessible.

During the Flight

- Store the carrier under the seat in front and speak to your pet to calm it.
- Keep your pet inside the carrier during the flight check with the crew if taking it out is permitted.
- Check on your pet regularly and make sure the temperature is comfortable – for example, place a light scarf over it if the cabin is too cold.
- Keep wipes or tissues ready in case of small accidents. Avoid feeding your pet during the flight (especially on short journeys).
